Park Manager- Park news from October. Anything else of interest to the membership. Bob Reports on activities for the last 30 days. We have selected a new resident artist. She has been coming to the festivals for a number of years.

There is a district CSO meeting on November 16th.

On the park boardwalks, the staff from Tallahassee is coming down this month for a face to face meeting. Confirmed that Stantec will be doing the drawings for the existing boardwalks in the park and all decks around the restrooms.

There was a meeting of staff with Collier County about a promised survey after all of the building of the turnaround and restrooms at the entrance to the park. The county believes we are not meeting our carrying capacity in the park. There had been, at one time, a proposal for a parking garage. The staff will rely on volunteers to count people coming in from the south boundary to assess who are just walking through the park or do they stay in the park? They are trying to determine percentages of those who actually use the park. This will supplement the count at the gate.
