Waiting on permits to get the boardwalks and ramps up to code. Will start in BH #1 & 3. Area 2 behind lift station needed the valve box replaced. The mangrove boardwalk is under assessment by the state bureau chiefs. Met with Estuary Conservation Assn who wishes to partner with us over concerns about water quality.
