Research description of Gopher Tortoise (Gopherus polyphemus) work at Delnor-

Wiggins Pass State Park

Florida's coastal habitats are home to many threatened and endangered species that are under increasing pressure of habitat loss resulting from human development in the region. The Gopher Tortoise (*Gopherus polyphemus*) is one such species that is dependent on coastal dune and pine flatwoods habitats. Unfortunately, wildlife managers have very little



information regarding tortoise ecology and population structure in coastal dune habitats. Therefore, the Herpetology Research Lab at FGCU is investigating a population of tortoises within Delnor-Wiggins Pass State Park (Collier County, Florida). This research includes: a tortoise burrow survey, a mark-recapture study and genetic analyses to help us determine the population structure; as well as a radio telemetry study to better understand habitat use and behavior of these individuals.

\*Additionally, we will be offering weekly educational programs to raise awareness for Gopher Tortoise conservation and the importance of the parks system to wildlife and ecosystem conservation. Our findings will be used to not only describe this population but will also be compared to several other populations, which we are also currently studying, to determine unique management considerations for coastal dune Gopher Tortoise populations.


FGCU Environmental Studies student, Christopher Tesmer will explain and demonstrate this on-going research. Meet at the Pavilion in area 5.
