Once a week she swims from Area #1 to Area #5 and back, continuing a long time tradition of ocean swimming in her native country, Venezuela. She walks the same distance when the Gulf is too cold for swimming and enjoys the beauty of the beach and the water as she walks the 2 mile distance.

Milagros grew up in Caracas and attended the Universidad Catolica Andres Bello, majoring in Civil Engineering. A Fulbright Scholarship brought her to MIT where she completed a master's degree in Civil Engineering and then returned to Venezuela to work for two years in her chosen field. She returned to MIT and this time she got a master's degree in Management and while there she met her husband, Kevin, also an engineer. Milagros and Kevin got married in New York where she worked at Chase Manhattan Bank. Job changes took the Dougans to Chicago and finally to Michigan where they raised their family and where she served as assistant treasurer at the University of Michigan.
