FLORIDA GULF COAST UNIVERSITY

We are very excited to have the first ever Gopher Tortoise survey and study being conducted at the park. Even more exciting is that it is being done by **FGCU Department of Biological Sciences** under the direction of Professor Phil Allman, PhD. Dr. Allman and several Graduate students started last Friday and found many more burrows that they ever expected. They installed radio tags on 5 tortoises and plan to visit twice per week to locate the animals. When the study is complete, a presentation will be given to staff and volunteers so stay tuned for that announcement.


