
Sea turtle nesting update

Our sea turtle nesting season is officially over. We had our last nest laid a few weeks ago which brings our grand total of nests to 54. We've also had many successful hatchings this season and are continuing to monitor the nests on the beach. We expect to have the remainder of our nests hatch over the next 4 weeks. Please remember to remove all of your items from the beach and fill in holes before heading home. Hatchlings can get caught in small pieces of trash and holes while making their way to the water.
