## **News and Reminders for All Volunteers:**

  be asked to sign a new Volunteer Agreement and complete State required training. Lori is
  in the process of updating the volunteer files and will let you know when you're due for
  renewal.
- New Emergency Information sheet for Volunteers: We are asking volunteers to fill out
  a quick form that will contain their emergency information. This form will be used by staff

- Over the last year we introduced a new volunteer position, Beach Steward. It has been a great success and we will be continuing the program. If anyone is interested in becoming a Beach Steward, contact Lori.
